

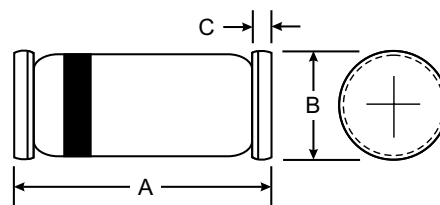

FIG.1-- ADMISSIBLE POWER DISSIPATION VS. AMBIENT TEMPERATURE

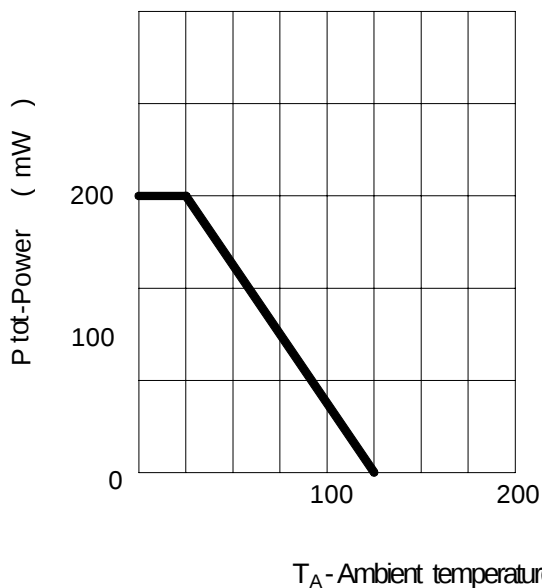


FIG. 2-- TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

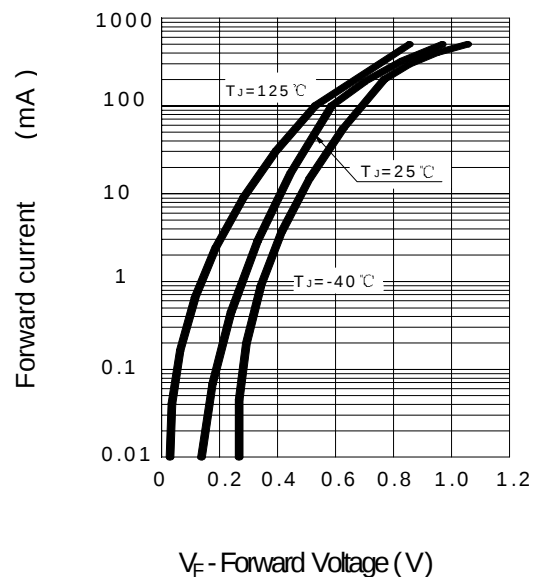


FIG. 3 - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

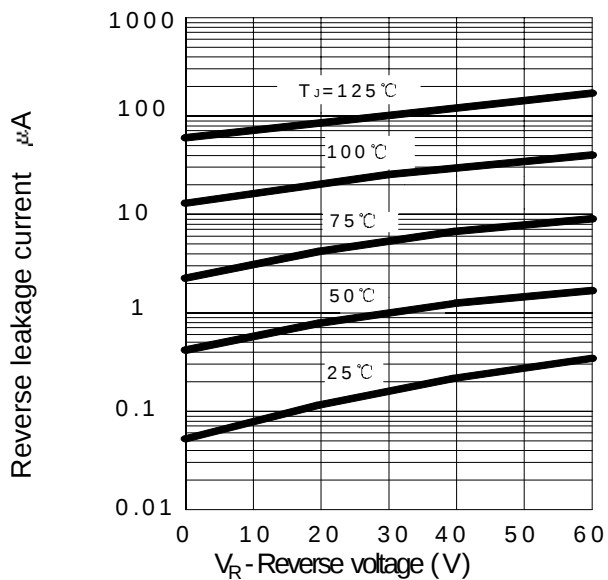


FIG.4 -- TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE
