



Figure 1. Output Characteristics (T_J = 25°C)




Figure 3. Drain Current vs. Temperature




Figure 5. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 2. Body Diode Forward Voltage




Figure 4. BV_{DSS} Variation vs. Temperature





Figure 6. On-Resistance vs. Temperature









Figure 8. Gate Charge 10 V_{GS}, Gate-to-Source Voltage (V) $V_{DD} = 160V$ 8 V_{DD} =400V $V_{DD} = 640 V$ 6 4 2 0 20 0 10 30 Q_g, Total Gate Charge (nC)



Gate Charge Waveform



Resistive Switching Test Circuit






Figure 14. Diode Reverse Recovery
Test Circuit




Figure 15. Diode Reverse Recovery Waveform






Figure 16. Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit
